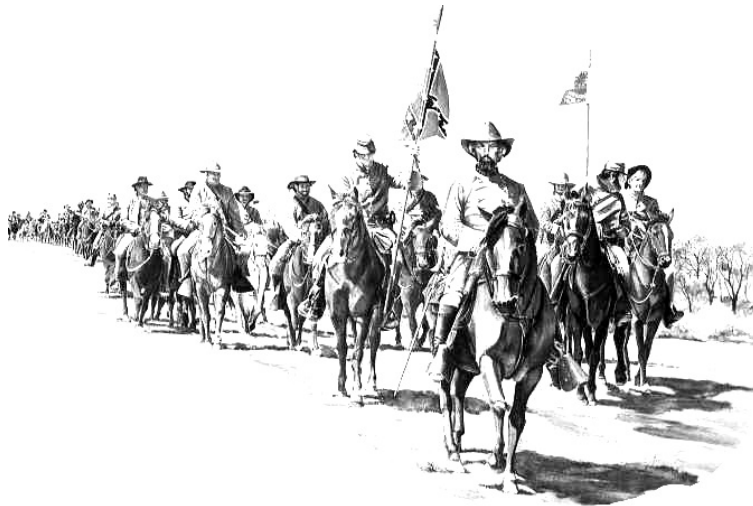

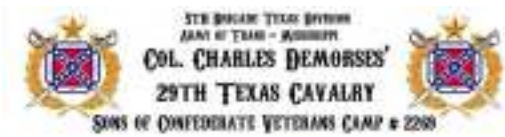
Dear Compatriot's of the,

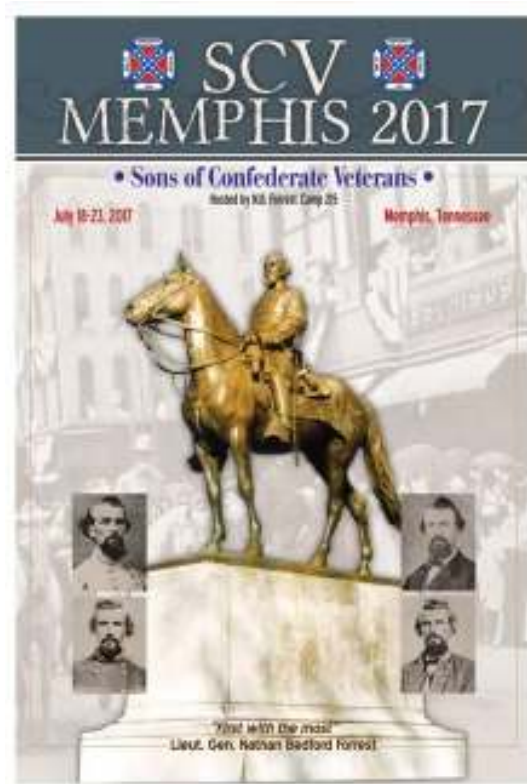
